Disguise your data to protect your identity fortress!

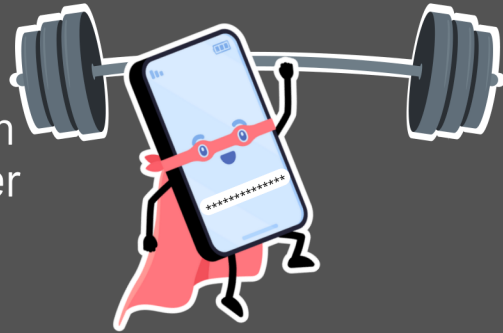
Wear your digital mask and cape: if you must, lie to safeguard your privacy and security!

6 Before you trust, investigate that link.

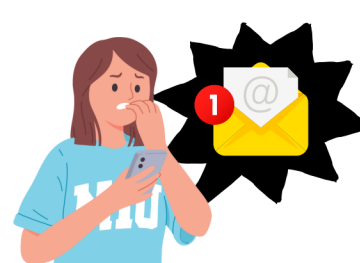
Links give YOU the power to uncover who is behind them and what they want.

If you didn't start the conversation, be extra cautious when replying.

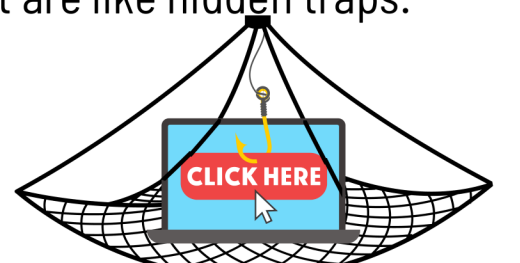


Curious or concerned? Ask a friend or look them up yourself.
