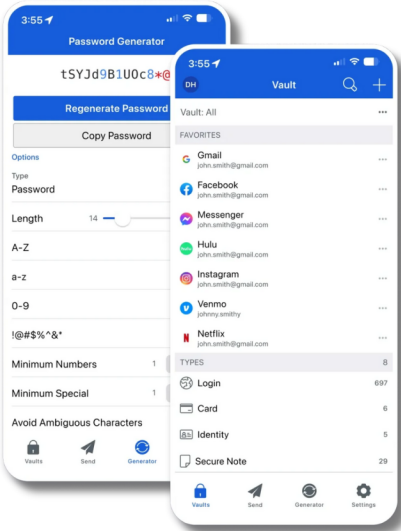


A Password Manager Program:

- Generates unique, strong passwords for you to use
- Stores and manages your online credentials securely
- Keeps track of passwords and the fake information you provide to security questions

Use a Unique Password for Each of your Accounts

Creating a unique password for each of your accounts can seem intimidating, but a password manager will create and remember them for you!



Never Manually Type a Password Again!

Simply copy + paste your passwords from the manager into the login fields when logging into your accounts

Reducing how often you manually type your passwords

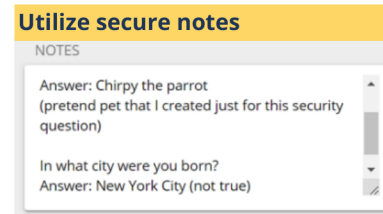
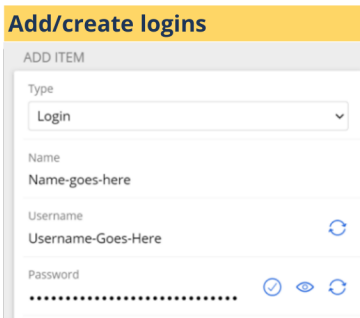
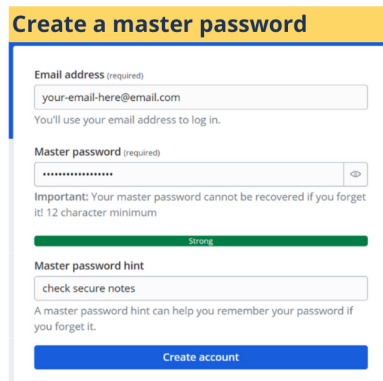
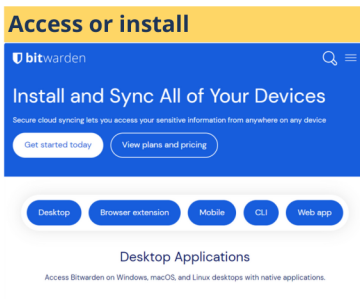


Reducing the opportunity your passwords may be recorded by keyloggers

Keyloggers: Malicious software or hardware that record everything you type on your keyboard, including your passwords.
