These images can cause emotional distress, reputational damage, and could be used for sextortion. It's crucial for students to understand that while AI makes it easy to create such content, the real-world repercussions are significant. The increasing occurrence of 'DeepNudes' among Canadian high school students highlights the need for urgent action. As AI technology becomes more easily accessible, it is imperative for educators to proactively address the potential harms associated with its misuse. These discussions can help students understand the implications of their digital actions and promote a respectful and safe online environment.

- Incorporate discussion of AI intimate image creation in cyberbullying lessons to promote prosocial and respectful behaviours on social media.
- Discuss the creation of such images within lessons on appropriate and inappropriate uses of AI and technology, both in and outside the classroom.

Staying updated on the latest technologies, platforms, and trends is important to effectively facilitate open discussions about online behaviors and foster responsible digital citizenship.

Educators can:

- Facilitate regular tech talks with students to discuss current technologies and online trends
- Engage with popular teen applications and explore trending videos and topics
